















Tackling Informality Why is it so high?








Vulnerable to Poverty (%, simulations, 2008-10)









Ingredients of a strategy

Labor regulation:
make formalization
less costly for
employers

- Part time and short-term work?
- Protect workers rather than jobs?
- Progressive contributions?

Compliance: make informality <u>more</u> costly for employers and workers

- Higher frequency inspection?
- Targeted on labor market informality?
- Coordination across agencies?

Partnership and outreach: underline the benefits of formality

- Partner with unions and NGOs?
- Provide information about benefits?
- Make informality "unacceptable"?
